

Religious Studies Phase One Curriculum

Overview:

The Religious Studies curriculum equips students with a strong command of explicit knowledge surrounding two of the main faiths within British Society. Christianity is the most followed religion globally, whilst Islam is one of the fastest growing religions. The Year 7 curriculum will equip students with the key theological understanding of these two religions, whilst the Year 8 curriculum will allow students to put these theological understandings into practice. They will examine religious teachings on contemporary issues such as racism, war and the care for our environment. They will also begin to understand where their own ethical opinions come from, beginning to understand their own views on the world around them. This is in line with the national curriculum that also has a clear focus on the wider world. This process will also enable them to apply religious concepts to demonstrate critical thinking and reasoning skills which will allow our students to be culturally aware.
