Present tense regular—er verbs:-

The –er verbs in French are a group of verbs that all have the same endings in the present tense.

-ger verbs keep the ‘e’ in the nous form

-yer verbs replace the ‘y’ with an ‘i’ for I, you, he/she and they form.

jouer - to play	envoyer - to send	partager - to share
Je jou <u>e</u>	J'envo <u>i</u> e	Je partag <u>e</u>
Tu jou <u>es</u>	Tu envo <u>i</u> es	Tu partag <u>es</u>
Il/Elle jou <u>e</u>	Il/Elle envo <u>i</u> e	Il/Elle partag <u>e</u>
Nous jou <u>ons</u>	Nous envoy <u>ons</u>	Nous partag <u>eons</u>

The verb faire:

To talk about online activities we use the verb ‘faire’.

Faire is an irregular verb—you need to learn the endings by heart.

faire—to do	
Je fais	I do
Tu fais	You do
Il/Elle fait	He/She does
Nous faisons	We do
Vous faites	You do
Ils/Elles font	They do

Week 5 and 6 Grammar

The negative

To say ‘not/don’t’ or ‘never’ in French you need to use a negative. In French, negatives go around the verb:

Je fais= I do

Je **ne** fais **pas** = I don’t do

Je **ne** fais **jamais** = I never do
